When adopting a puppy the move to a new home, the change of water, routines etc can upset the pup's tummy

Please before you are in need of this and as a precaution buy a fresh chicken.

Boil with at least 4 pints of water until the meat falls of the bone. Keep and bottle in small bottles the broth.

Package the chicken to small egg cup sized packages and freeze and also have a few packs of Natures Diet puppy food in store.

If the pup gets an upset tum skip one meal (to rest its tummy) then feed an egg cup of thawed chicken with a mug of broth and water. Rub with fingers till it's like a soup, and the pup will not need to chew and break it down.

Let the pup eat it warm. It will fill it's tum up with fluid and a little chicken, this keeps it hydrated.

Mix 1/8 of a small ripe banana with this mixed in well at least once a day.

Feed this for 2 days, then add a little Natures Diet slowly – so less chicken more Natures Diet.

Then slowly reduce the fluid and increase the Nature's Diet and gradually and very slowly introduce kibble of your choice.

This all works well. Adjust to size of pup and you should adjust the quantities in relation to the size of your pup. If in doubt email info@manytearsrescue.org

Catch early - remember dehydration kills pups.
